August 14-16, 2026

Rules

1. Non-refundable Entry Fee of \$50,000 and participation is by invitation only and is at the sole and absolute discretion of Venetian Las Vegas Gaming, LLC ("The Venetian").
2. Participants must be at least 21 years of age and a Venetian Rewards member to participate in The Crowne Classic or any of its functions ("Tournament").
3. Each eligible participant will be issued a Tournament session card at event registration containing participant's session time, table number, and seat number.
4. Participants must register for their seating assignment no later than 4:45 p.m. on Friday, August 14, 2026.
5. All participants must arrive at the Tournament tables at least ten (10) minutes prior to their scheduled session time.
6. Full Buy-in amount of \$50,000 must be received by Friday, August 7, 2026.
7. The Tournament consists of a Roulette Tournament, Baccarat Tournament, Blackjack Tournament, Craps Tournament and Slot Promotion. The number of tables used and the number of participants per table will be determined by the total number of Tournament participants. Tournament staff shall use its best efforts to uniformly distribute the number of participants per table.
8. Participants shall compete in five (5) designated casino games to accumulate Tournament Leaderboard Points ("Tournament Leaderboard Points"). Upon completion of each game, participants shall be ranked based on their performance and awarded Tournament Leaderboard Points in descending order. The highest-ranked participant shall receive points equal to the total number of tournament participants, with each subsequent rank receiving one (1) fewer point than the rank immediately preceding it, and the lowest-ranked participant receiving one (1) point. The participant with the highest cumulative Tournament Leaderboard Point total following completion of all five (5) games shall be declared the Tournament Champion.
9. In the event of a tie in an individual game, all tied participants shall receive the full point value associated with the highest finishing position achieved. For example, if two (2) participants tie for 1st Place in a game with fifty (50) participants, each participant shall be awarded fifty (50) Tournament Leaderboard Points. The next highest-ranked participant shall be awarded points for the next available finishing position after the tied positions. In this example, no 2nd Place shall be awarded, and the next participant shall be ranked 3rd Place and receive forty-eight (48) Tournament Leaderboard Points.
10. Participants who conclude an individual game session with a score of zero (0) shall receive zero (0) Tournament Leaderboard Points for that game.
11. Any participant who misses a game will receive zero (0) points for that specific game.
12. In the event of a tie two or more participants finish the tournament with the exact same cumulative Tournament Leaderboard Point total, the tie will be broken using the following sequential criteria:
 - a. Individual Game Score: The participant with the higher score in the highest-priority game shall be awarded the higher finishing position. If the tied participants have identical scores in that game, the comparison shall proceed sequentially through the remaining games in the order listed below until the tie is broken (e.g. If Participant A and Participant B each finish with a cumulative Tournament Leaderboard Point total of one hundred fifty (150), the participant with the higher Blackjack score shall be awarded the higher finishing position. If the Blackjack scores are identical, the Craps scores shall be compared, followed by Roulette, Baccarat, and Slots, as necessary, until the tie is resolved.)
 - i. Blackjack
 - ii. Craps
 - iii. Roulette
 - iv. Baccarat
 - v. Slots

- b. Card Ranking: In the event a tie remains after application of the Priority Scoring System, the tied participants shall participate in a random card draw. Thirteen (13) unique cards from a single suit, consisting of one (1) card of each rank and no duplicate ranks, shall be shuffled and placed face down. Each tied participant shall select one (1) card. The participant selecting the highest-ranking card shall be awarded the higher finishing position. For purposes of the card draw, card rankings shall be, from highest to lowest: Ace, King, Queen, Jack, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, and 2.
13. All participants must present their session cards to the dealer when they arrive at the table. In the event a participant loses their original session card, a replacement card will be issued, and stamped "DUPLICATE". The Venetian event staff will hand the duplicate card directly to the dealer upon entry to the session.

ROULETTE TOURNAMENT

14. Each participant will receive \$25,000 in Tournament chips at the beginning of play. Exchanging of chips between participants is prohibited. All bets must be in multiples of \$100 with a minimum bet of \$100 and a maximum bet of \$1,000 anyway with exception of outside even money and 2-1 wagers that have the following limits, \$15,000 and \$30,000 respectively. Additionally, for the last spin of each round each participant may choose to go "all in" on the outside even money and 2-1 wagers. Once a bet is placed in the betting circle, it cannot be changed. Inside wagers remain the same limits on the final spin of each round. Tournament will be played in single 0 games.
15. The tournament will consist of twenty (20) spins. Participants must play every spin or be disqualified from the Tournament.
16. The dealer will place a lammer on the betting layout to indicate the start of the betting period. All bets must be placed by the participant.
17. All bets must cease after the dealer signals no more bets. Any late bets will be returned to the participant and will not be eligible for play.
18. All standard inside and outside bets are permitted. Payouts will conform to standard American Roulette odds.
19. Participants are responsible for their own chips and ensuring their bets are placed correctly on the layout.
20. If a participant has less than the minimum bet remaining, the participant is eliminated from play and shall immediately vacate his or her seat and leave the Tournament area.
21. In the event of a game malfunction, the spin will be declared void and all chips will be returned. The round will continue with an additional spin.

BACCARAT TOURNAMENT

22. The tournament will be played entirely out of one (1) continuous shoe. Participants must play every hand or be disqualified from the Tournament.
23. A eight (8) deck shoe will be used at all times.
24. Exchanging of Tournament chips between participants is prohibited. Once a bet is placed in the betting circle, it cannot be changed.
25. All bets must be in multiples of \$500 as noted below:

26. All games will be dealt by the dealer at all times.
27. Participants may play only one (1) hand at a time and must play the circle in front of them. All chips must be kept in plain sight and stacked by denomination. Chips may not be removed from the table for any reason. Participants are asked to refrain from covering or concealing chips in any manner during play including excessive handling of chips.
28. Each participant will place his or her bet in turn within a timely manner as determined by the Tournament Director. All bets must be placed separately, (no string betting).
29. Participants must place a wager on either the Player or the Banker every hand and may not wager on the Player and the Banker simultaneously. Side bets, (Tie's and Tiger's) must be placed prior to betting Player/Banker.
30. Participants may not wager on a Tie, Tiger, Tiger Pair, Small Tiger, or Big Tiger bets in lieu of a Player or a Banker bet. Once the Player/Banker bet is placed their betting is complete.
31. Banker wins with 6, pays full wager. No commission will be charged on winning Banker wagers.
32. Dealers may pay bets in any denomination of chips they deem appropriate.
33. In the event of a misdeal by the dealer, the hand will be reset according to procedures and the rules of baccarat, and any unused exposed cards will be used in the next hand. The next hand, using the exposed card, will be played as a "free hand" with no bets taken. Tournament will then continue on the following hand.
34. No cards will be backed up.
35. If a participant has less than the minimum bet remaining, the participant is eliminated from play and shall immediately vacate his or her seat and leave the Tournament area.
36. In case of a dispute, it is the participants responsibility to bring it to the attention of the Tournament Director or Floor Supervisor immediately and before the next hand is dealt. The decision of the Tournament Director is final.

BLACKJACK TOURNAMENT

37. The tournament will be played entirely out of one (1) continuous shoe as heads up one (1) player per table. Participants must play every hand or be disqualified from the Tournament.
38. A six (6) deck shoe will be used at all times.
39. Each participant will receive \$25,000 in Tournament chips at the beginning of play. Exchanging of chips between participants is prohibited. All bets must be in multiples of \$100 with a minimum bet of \$100 and a maximum bet of \$10,000, with exception of the last hand of each session in which a participant may choose to go "all in". Pair side bet \$100 to \$500. Once a bet is placed in the betting circle, it cannot be changed.
40. Participants may play only one (1) hand at a time and must play the circle in front of them. All chips must be kept in plain sight and stacked by denomination. Chips may not be removed from the table for any reason. Participants are asked to refrain from covering or concealing chips in any manner during play including excessive handling of chips.
41. All participants' cards will be dealt face up and participants will not handle the cards. Participants are asked to keep their hands in plain sight at all times.
42. Each participant will place their bet in turn within a timely manner as determined by the Tournament Director.
43. It is the participants responsibility to communicate their desired action with the dealer, by using a hand signal. The first hand signal is final.
44. The number of rounds, sessions, times, may be adjusted based on the total number of Tournament participants.
45. Dealers may pay bets in any denomination of chips they deem appropriate.

46. If a dealer deals cards out of order and no one has acted upon their hand, all hands are dead.
47. No cards will be backed up.
48. If a participant has less than the minimum bet remaining, the participant is eliminated from play and shall immediately vacate their seat and leave the Tournament area.
49. There will be no surrender in this Tournament. Dealer will stand on soft 17.
50. Insurance may be taken in an amount up to one-half the participant's original bet. The dealer will ask for insurance once, beginning with the puck and moving to the right. The participant must give a hand signal if they do not want insurance and that decision cannot be changed once it is made.
51. Participants may not get even money in lieu of taking insurance when they have a blackjack during Tournament play.
52. Participants may not hit or double down when dealt a Blackjack, twenty-one (21), on their first two cards.

CRAPS TOURNAMENT

53. Each participant will receive \$25,000 in Tournament chips at the beginning of play. Exchanging of chips between participants is prohibited. All bets must be in multiples of \$100 with a minimum bet of \$500 on Pass Line or Don't Pass Line for every shooter's come-out roll and a maximum bet of \$5,000, with exception of the last shooter in which a participant may choose to go "all in" on the pass or don't pass line. Once a bet is placed in the betting circle, it cannot be changed. Tournament will be played on craps games.
54. Players must remain in their assigned table position as designated at registration. The player assigned Position #1 will begin each round as the first shooter.
55. When the dice pass to the next shooter, all chips will be cleared from the table. Each participant is required to shoot in turn; passing the dice is not permitted.
56. When the stick person announces "No more bets," all wagering for that roll must cease immediately.
57. Players are limited to a maximum of two (2) bets on any single number (e.g., a Come bet plus a Place or Buy bet), excluding one (1) roll bets.
58. All wagers must be made in increments of \$500 chips, except for 6 and 8 bets, which must be placed in increments of \$600 chips. Hardway bets are permitted with a minimum of \$100 chips and a maximum of \$500 chips, and must be placed in increments of \$100 chips. All other proposition bets are not allowed.
59. Field bets must be placed with a minimum of \$500 chips and a maximum of \$5,000 chips.
60. All Come, Don't Come, Place, Lay, and other applicable bets must be placed in proper increments to ensure payouts equate exactly to \$100 chip increments. For example, a lay bet of \$500 chips to win \$250 is not permitted; a minimum lay bet of \$600 chips is required to yield a \$300 chip payout.
61. Each tournament session shall consist of seventy-five (75) minutes of play. Each table shall be limited to a maximum of eight (8) participants. During the session, each participant shall be entitled to one (1) turn as the shooter. A participant's turn as shooter shall continue until a seven-out occurs, at which time the dice shall pass to the next eligible participant in rotation. If the seventy-five (75) minute session time limit expires before all participants have had an opportunity to serve as shooter, play shall immediately conclude, and any participant who has not yet served as shooter shall forfeit their opportunity to do so. No additional time shall be granted to complete the rotation of shooters.
62. Once all wagers have been settled, the box person or stick person will announce "No more bets." The dice will then be delivered to the shooter, and no late bets will be accepted.
63. Players must have an active wager on every roll. Call bets are strictly prohibited.

64. On each come-out roll, players are required to place a wager on either the Pass Line or Don't Pass line, but not both. Wagers must be a minimum of \$500 chips and may not exceed \$5,000 chips. These bets must remain in place until a decision is reached. Players may increase their Pass Line bet up to the table maximum and may reduce their Don't Pass bet, provided it does not fall below the table minimum.

SLOT PROMOTION

65. The promotion will take place on designated Dragon Link machines within the Palazzo High Limit Lounge. Once a machine has been selected, participants may not change machines during the promotion.
66. Upon registration, each participant will be issued a temporary, event-specific slot card ("Temp Card"). This card is pre-loaded with \$5,000 in Slot Credit. Play is strictly limited to this initial \$5,000 balance. Participants are permitted to play until the \$5,000 slot credit is fully exhausted; however, wagering of earned/won credits is strictly prohibited. Must play on a \$5 denomination. No maximum bet limit applies.
67. A Guest Service Representative ("GSR") will be assigned to each active participant. The GSR will manually track and log the machine's dollar amount meter at the conclusion of the allotted spins to determine the participant's official promotion result.
68. Participants are permitted to keep 100% of any actual cash winnings earned from the slot machine during their promotional play.
69. A participant's final promotion score shall be based solely on the ending cash balance as reflected on the Dragon Link machine's Ticket-In, Ticket-Out ("TITO") ticket upon completion of play. The amount printed on the TITO ticket will be deemed the official and final promotion score for promotion purposes. If a taxable jackpot (\$2,000 or greater) will trigger a standard handpay. The GSR will log the win toward the promotion score, and the jackpot will be processed according to standard gaming regulations.
70. To ensure seamless operational tracking, all points, play history, and final balances accumulated on the Temp Card will be merged into the participant's live Venetian Rewards account following the conclusion of the promotion session.

GENERAL

71. Participants must initial the official score sheet verifying that the recorded score is correct after the end of each tournament. Failure to do so will result in the disqualification of that tournament's score.
72. Prizes won will be awarded to the participant named as winner. Disposition of the winnings and payment of applicable taxes are the responsibility of the participant.
73. Tournament Results will be available at the Tournament area. Cash prizes must be claimed at The Palazzo Casino Cage within forty-eight (48) hours of conclusion of the Tournament. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of prize.
74. Tournament rules will be available at the event registration desk.
75. Substitute participants are prohibited, and accommodations will not be made for scheduling conflicts. Failure of Tournament participant to report at appointed times may result in forfeiture.
76. All Tournament tables will be non-smoking, and no beverage service will be available during Tournament play.
77. No written material or electronic devices, including cellular phones, are allowed during Tournament play.
78. English is the required language during active tournament play. No communication in any other language is permitted at the table while a hand is in progress, unless conducted through a Casino Representative. No communication, either verbal or visual, is permitted between participants or between participants and spectators that could influence play. Players may converse in any language when not actively involved in a hand or away from the table. Tournament staff may intervene in any situation where communication may impact game integrity or create an actual or perceived unfair advantage.



VENETIAN REWARDS

79. The Venetian reserves the right to deny or reject the participation of any person for any reason in its sole judgment and discretion. Any dispute will be resolved by The Venetian; however, all decisions are subject to the patron's right to file a dispute with the Nevada Gaming Control Board.
80. In accordance with Nevada Gaming Control Board regulations, The Venetian reserves the right to cancel, modify, or amend this Event. Any material changes after the Event has commenced will be implemented in compliance with applicable regulatory requirements. In the event of a Tournament cancellation, entry fees will be refunded.
81. Failure to adhere to the Tournament rules will result in disqualification and/or forfeiture of any winnings.
82. This Tournament shall take place Friday, August 14, 2026, through Saturday, August 15, 2026, unless changed or terminated earlier by The Venetian management in its sole judgment and discretion without prior notice.
83. This Tournament shall be subject to the Venetian Rewards Terms and Conditions.
